PP vs non PP

- ❖ PP pupils are more likely to follow a vocational college route than non PP pupils.
- ❖ PP pupils are more likely to find an apprenticeship.
- ❖ Our 2 NEET pupils comprise of 1 PP and 1 non-PP pupil. Approx 2% of each cohort.

SEND vs non SEND

- ❖ No SEND pupils went to QE compared to 38.1% of non-SEND (for some SEND pupils QE is not an appropriate choice)
- ❖ No variation in the destinations of SEND pupils they all went to Darlington College, except for the 1 NEET pupil.
- ❖ 1/8 SEND pupils is NEET (This pupil has an EHCP) 12.5% of SEND pupils compared to 1.2% of non-SEND. 1 NEET pupil was SEND and 1 was not.

MAT vs non-MAT

- ❖ Majority followed an academic route.
- ❖ None were NEET

Males vs females

- ❖ Both NEET pupils are male. 4.3% of males are NEET
- ❖ Equal proportions of males and females found apprenticeships.
- ❖ Generally equal proportions of males and females chose similar destinations except for the specialist Engineering provisions such as UTC which was chosen by more males.

EAL vs non-EAL

- ❖ A higher proportion of EAL pupils went to QE than non-EAL
- ❖ A higher proportion of EAL pupils found Apprenticeships than non-EAL pupils.
