



Wyvern Academy: CPD Offer during remote working

As a school we are committed to staff development and the rationale behind this CPD provision is to allow staff to continue to develop their practice throughout the period of school closure and as well as make use of the wealth of quality, free online CPD that is available at the moment. Taking into account the differing circumstances of home working life, the vast majority of these online courses are accessible at flexible times and can be tailored to staff's needs.

The accompanying booklet offers staff the information around what is available online and a fortnightly newsletter can then be used to offer courses and reviews of completed CPD by staff. Also on offer are short internal CPD sessions ran by staff who have volunteered to lead a session in something they are confident with or trialled based on school priorities from this year and into next year.
