If you have a college place

Apply on-line as soon as possible.

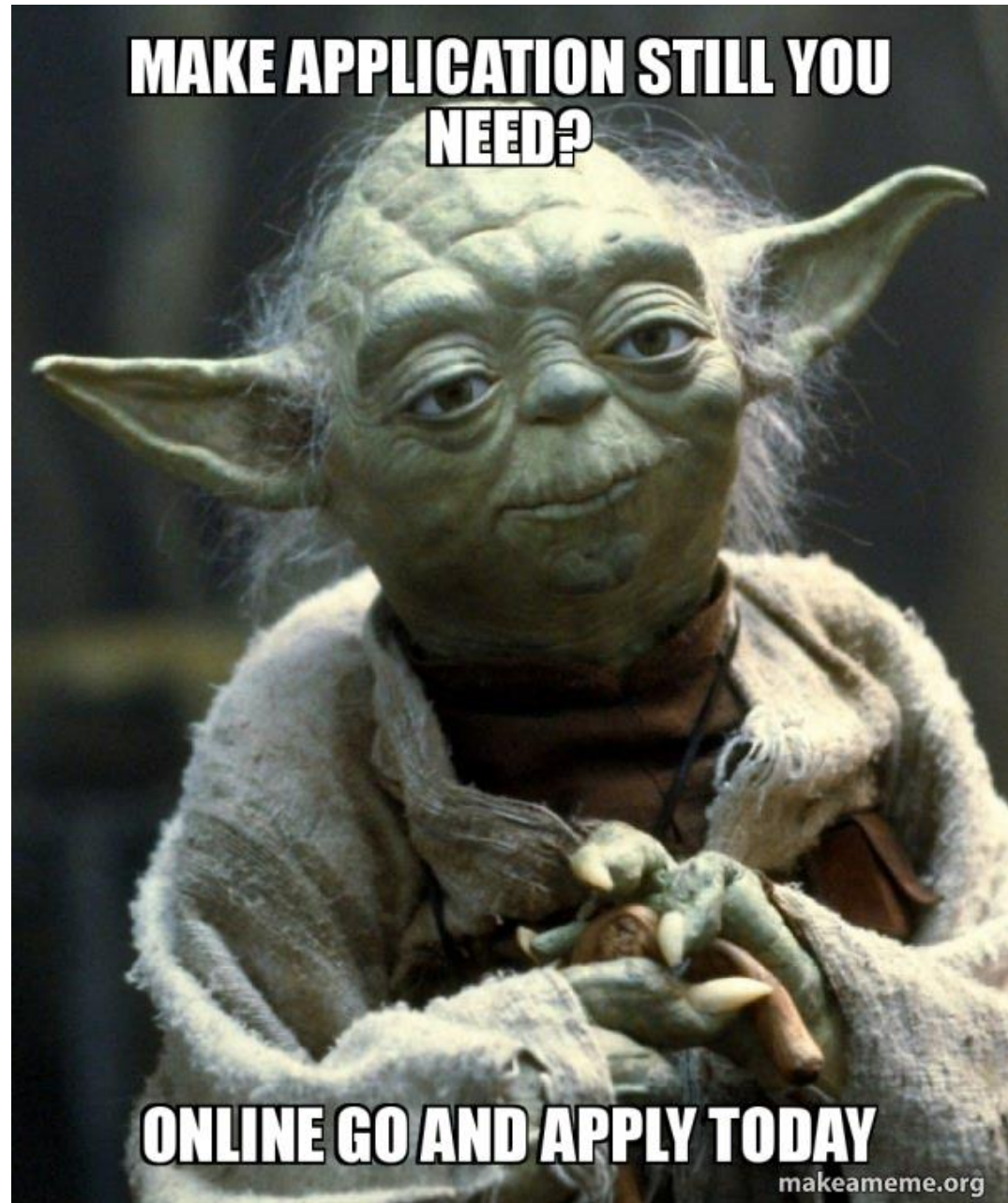
If you are not sure which course to pick you can

Keep working on your fitness so you are ready when they restart the fitness tests.

Have a plan B in case you have a delayed start or fail the fitness/medical tests

What should I do?

If you need help to make your plans

Talk to your parents/carers. They are the best people to talk to first as they know you and can sit with you to look at college courses and apprenticeship vacancies on your phone or computer.

Email Mrs Gibbins using your school email account.

She can arrange to ring you for a chat about your options but she must ring a parent's phone and someone else must be there when she calls.




